But to highlight the simple points here goes: -



#### Hygiene

- No sharing of towels/water bottles/food, including lollies
- Any areas (meeting rooms, treatment rooms, Change rooms etc) accessed by players and officials to be comprehensibly cleaned and sanitised after each use
  - Clubs to take steps to adequately Clean and disinfect player facilities (once available) before and after use

 Clubs must do all they can to reinforce the above precautions, including making available appropriate hand washing facilities, as well as the provision of alcohol-based hand sanitiser and tissues

From the BNSW website:

#### REQUIREMENTS AFTER JULY 1St

At a minimum there shall be adherence as per the above referred NSW Department of Health Public Order Guidelines;

- Please refer to revised BNSW Return to Competition Plan'
- · No restriction on how many registered members may gather
- Clubs and Associations are still required to retain an attendance Checklist of all registered members present at any facility
  - This does not apply to spectators
  - There will be NO restricted Activity Zones
  - Change rooms and toilets will be available for use
